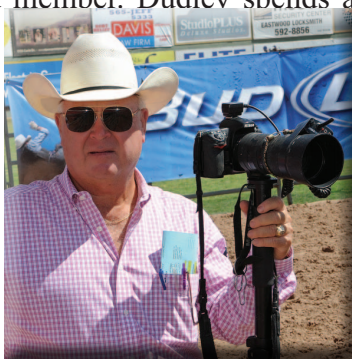
Hall of Fame



Born August 30, 1944 in Taylor, Texas, Dudley helped with the family ranch before going to college and the military.

He attended Texas A&M University, receiving a Master's degree in Animal Science plus three teaching certificates. Before finishing his education, he completed 4 years in the United States Marine Corps as Captain with a tour in Vietnam.

In August 1975, he moved to Stephenville, Texas where rodeo was prevalent. Soon after, he started a business as a full-time professional rodeo photographer--Doright Enterprises--and for over 42 years and still going, Dudley Barker has been preserving rodeo memories as a professional photographer with the Professional Rodeo Cowboy Association (PRCA) as a Gold Card member. Dudley spends a majority of his time traveling across the Southwest, in addition to various ranch rodeos, ropings & junior rodeos. He has been honored with an induction in the Texas Rodeo Cowboy Hall of Fame and the 2009 PRCA Photographer of the Year. These events including over 35 NFRs having been captured in a Book- "5 Decades of Rodeo", on a DVD-"Lifetime of Action"-covering
