Kevin got on his first bull making a qualified ride in Newton, Tx. 1974. The bull didn't buck much but he was hooked on riding after his first ride.

He started going to open rodeo's but didn't get another one rode untill 1976.(learning curve, 101.)

He won the Summer Series at Honey Island in 1978

He won the Winter Series at Tin Top in 1979 & 1983.

Qualified for the LRA Finals in 1979.

Qualified for the TRA Finals in 1979 through 1985.

Won the TRA Bullriding Championship in 1983 after finishing in the Top Three in 1980, 81 & 82.

In 1979, 80 & 81 he qualified for the Tri-State Finals.

Two time North American qualifier representing Texas in 1983 & 1984.

TRA Bullriding Director 1983, 1984 & 1985.

He also fought bulls for Herbert Peveto in Leesville, La.

He is most proud of being the first bullrider to get a qualified ride on the following unridden bulls; #27 Moby Dick of Nicky Wheeler, #93 Whirlpool of Rabbit Litton, #6 Jelly Bean of George Haynes, #100 Cement of Johnny Ackels, #58 Detour of Terry Walls, RD Rodney Dangerfield of Longhorn Rodeo Co., Snuffy Smith of Smith Rodeo Co., Painted Demon of Dan Harris, #51 Screwdriver of Larkin Franklin and Bar 11 Bar Fly of David Bailey.
