Born May 22, 1922. Jack died September 29, 1988.

J.B. began rodeoing in the mid 1930s at the age of fourteen. He broke horses for the Mayan Ranch in Bandera, Texas for 50 cents a head. He competed in bare back bronc riding, saddle bronc riding and steer wrestling at major rodeos from Madison Square Garden to Calgary. His winnings include:
