Entering her first rodeo at the age of 3, Jackie Bob Riggs Cox was born to rodeo. Her mother was Ora

Altizer Riggs (Texas Rodeo Hall of Fame and a founding member of the Girls Rodeo Association). Her father was calf

roper Jack Riggs (Pecos Rodeo Hall of Fame). As a child, she ran barrels at the GRA level against such greats as

Wanda Bush, Jane Mayo, and Sherry Combs while rodeoing with her parents. Jackie Bob was 11 years old when she

won the first barrel race ever held at the Cheyenne Frontier Days rodeo and the prestigious West of the Pecos RCA

Rodeo. She won the barrel race at the Pecos rodeo again in 1968 and 1969 along with numerous other GRA rodeo wins as a child.

Jackie Bob attended Texas Tech University majoring in math and economics while doing a little rodeoing -

competing in the barrels and breakaway roping. In 1975, Jackie Bob was crowned the Texas Tech Rodeo Queen,

went on to win Miss Rodeo Texas and was the First Runner-up to Miss Rodeo America. Jackie Bob married George

Cox and continued to rodeo, running barrels, and training futu-



rity barrel horses. She qualified for the National Finals Rodeo in 1986. She qualified for the Texas Circuit Finals 9 times. She won the barrel racing championship for the Texas Circuit finals in 1986 and 1990.

Jackie Bob's horses and students have been winners in the WPRA, BFA Futurities & Derbies, NIRA, THSRA, and many junior rodeo associations. Jackie Bob and George are active ranching, training barrel horses and young riders on their ranch near Ozona, Texas. They have one daughter: Kelsey Cox, and three grandchildren: Kiley Dean, Klacey Dean, and Ryker Dean.
