After completing a professional bull riding career in 2005, Royd became a PRCA, PBR, and ABBI American Bucking Bull, Inc official. He was a 14 time ABBI finals judge and 2 times as a PBR finals judge and is still very active in being an official.

Some of Royd proudest accomplishments are marrying his wife Tracie Havard Doyal, raising two great children, Cierra and Rance Doyal and watching them compete at every level of rodeo andl being inducted alongside my father, Red Doyal. They are one of only 4 father/son duos to compete at the NFR in the bull riding.
