48 Years in Rodeo

1967 Donny started working as a Bulfighter/Clown at Rodeo's for his Dad, Danny Green, a Stock Contractor to many of the Rodeos in the Northwest USA and Western Canada. From 1967 to 1973 he worked for many Stock Contractors at amateur rodeos refining his skills. In the fall of 1973 Donny joined the Rodeo Cowboy's Assoc. (Now the PRCA).

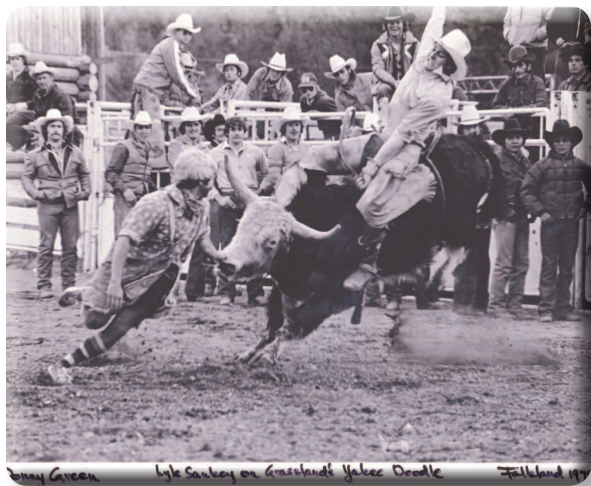
Through the years from 1974 to 2008, he worked the majority of all the Pro-Rodeos west of the Mississippi, the Midwest, West coast of the USA and Western Canada including: Calgary, Houston, Denver, Pendleton and all points in between. Many Circuit Finals, Canadian Finals, and INFR. 1972-1982 Winters were filled with driving log trucks or over the road trucks coast to coast. Other work was construction both sides of the border running caterpillar, excavators and scrapers.

1988 Donny took 1 1/2 years off the Rodeo Trail due to family and personal problems, surgeries, etc.

1986 Donny started flying airplanes and fixing them. 1987 he flew Jumpers at Sheridan in the C-180's and twin Beech.

1988 Donny worked for Evergreen International Airlines flying parts into the fires in Yellowstone and a short stint in Africa in Learjets.





Alaska Airlines hired Donny into the 737 for the next 5 years, and was still working 25-30 Rodeos a year!

1988 Donny came back to Rodeo, bringing back his Car Act, Skydiving, animal acts, and working the barrel. He managed a full schedule every

year until 2008, but from all the broken bones and much abuse from the Bulls, ...4 shoulder surgeries, knee surgeries, back surgery, broken jaws, legs, arms, and some think losing all his marbles at times..... he still continued until he retired in 2008

2004-2008 he was working the winter months overseas as a Secret Squirrel, in S. Korea, Iraq, Philippines.

Fall of 2008 went full time to 2014 (Engineer) on Surveillance Plane's doing Contracts in countries like: S. Korea, Iraq, Afghanistan, Dubai, Qatar, Kuwait, Thailand and the Philippines. He was injured overseas in 2015, shrapnel hit his left leg, tendons, muscles, nerves cut below the knee...and thank God the bone did not break...which stopped everything in his life. After 4 surgeries, casts and slow walking, it took healing for a couple years to walk again.

Donny Skydived into many of his rodeo performances north and south of the border, 2400+ skydives into rodeo's in his clown outfit!

Donny is a native Washintonian, But, during most of his rodeo years, he was



from Kamloops, British Columbia.

Now living in Ridgefield, Washington (15 miles NE of Portland, OR) his door is always open to old friends...
