



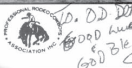

J. D. Nix was the son of Johnny Nix, a rodeo cowboy who competed in the sixties and seventies and was a rodeo champion. I first met Johnny at the Uvalde auction in the middle eighties as he was cattle buyer then. He was always very congenial and friendly. Later on I would see him at the estate sales around the Kerrville area. J. D. has a brother Clint who also rodeoed.

J. D. hit the rodeo trail and made quite a name for himself winning several big bullridings and rodeos. J. D. started building up a string of bulls in the nineties and as of 2004 is producing a lot of

open bullriding, sometimes in association with Wendell Munson of Pleasanton. The Nix Rodeo Company also has weekly practice bullridings at the Thousand Hills Cowboy Church arena close to Kerrville and at his home arena in Kerrville. He and Wendell have some of the best bucking bulls to be found anywhere!
