Bobby Robinson was born in Mineral Wells, Texas in 1944. His parents were Cullen and Mary Robinson (Cullen was inducted into the Texas Rodeo Cowboy Hall of Fame in 2007.). Bobby has a twin brother and older sister. Bobby began rodeoing at the age of 9 and is still rodeoing today.

Bobby is a former champion calf roper and steer wrestler of the TYRA and AJRA. Bobby obtained his R.C.A. permit while still in high school. Bobby is a Texas A&M graduate and was a member of the A&M Rodeo Team from 1962-1966. He was the NIRA Southern Region roping champion in 1965. Bobby participated in the College National Finals in 1964, 1965 and 1966 as a calf roper and steer wrestler.

As he got older Bobby joined the Texas Senior Pro Rodeo Association (TSRRA) and the National Old Time Roper's Association (NOTRA). Bobby is a former Vice President of the NOTRA organization. In 2004, Bobby was the Champion Breakaway Roper for the year in NOTRA. The next year (2005) Bobby was the Champion Roper and also won the Champion All-Around Cowboy Award for the year. In the team-roping event Bobby has been in the top 5 of the year end standings every year since 2004.
